

**Town of Green Lake**  
**Regular Town Board Meeting**  
**Monday, February 9, 2026**

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Supervisor Berndt called the regular town meeting to order at 7:05 PM. Chairman Moderow and Treasurer Machkovich were absent. There were 2 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Strelow, seconded by Berndt to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the minutes of the regular monthly meeting on January 12, 2026. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report** – the board members reviewed January report. There were \$4,744,965.09 in credits and \$2,291,170.49 debits. Tax collections is all done for the year. Reported balances on Money Market, CD and Phelps Savings Account. Motion to approve Treasurer's report and the transfer needed as presented by Berndt, seconded by Strelow. Motion carried.

**Maintenance Report** – They went out trimming trees, starting on Boelter Road, then Kearleys Landing. Along Lakeshore Drive overhanging branches were cut, but we'll need to remove many dead ash trees. Searl Road was also trimmed south of Miller Road. I'm planning on cutting small brush and getting the bucket truck for another couple days to do move trimming. Bearings were replaced on the pickup truck salter. The spinner for the 99 truck has been straightened. The parts are in for the 99 truck and it's second in line. Expecting it done in about a week. Picked up replacement wing blades as the 18 truck is worn pretty bad. The blades will be installed this week. I ordered paint for the parking lots as the lines are about gone. The lawn mower trailer received new tires, and the deck has been sealed. Also, the bearings were repacked with grease and new seals installed. We were selected for a drug test a couple weeks ago. All went well. I went through the Center Cemetery deeds and organized them. The drainage ditch on the end of Lakeshore is on private property and the part north of Lakeshore towards the woods is listed as a park. Our salt supply is doing pretty good too this year.
