

Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, July 14, 2025

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present for the meeting. There were 14 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Strelow/Berndt to approve the minutes from the regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 9, 2025. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report – Machkovich reported the June credits are \$19,712.17 and the debits are \$60,232.31. \$200,000 was transferred to a CD at Horicon Bank effective on June 20th for 31 day CD at 4.2%. We need a transfer for the Kartechner check in the amount of \$173,803.10. The loan balance is also \$285,314.30. Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt. No transfer needed this month.

Maintenance Report – The salt order will be delivered in September 100 tons @\$112.59 a ton. The cameras have been replaced at the boat landings as the old ones became weather damaged. We went around and replaced various sign posts. New sign posts have been ordered and also fire number posts. Oil has been changed in mower tractors and blades have been replaced on the mower. The 99' dump truck had an electrical fire at Horner's landing while we were removing a downed tree. The truck was towed to D&E Diesel in Markesan for repair. The truck is fixed and costs \$3057.00 to fix. The John Deere tractor had a fence post go through the front tire. The fire was junk and replaced. Trying to get the field hazard warranty. The Ford 580 will be dropped off at Homan Ford for an engine light. Cleaned up many trees down from the wind storm on June 23rd. Luedtke Road was trimmed as there were many broken branches. This week should finish the second pass mowing roads. Menominee and Lakewood paving went well, and the road looked good. Oakwood Beach, Kahl, Roy Creek, Phelps and Searle have been chipped and sealed. No tracking into driveways which is a good thing. Area Asphalt will be paving before Labor Day in Phelps Cemetery.

Vote to enact ordinance restricting certain artificial wake enhancement on Little Green Lake – Ordinance to prohibit certain artificial wake enhancement, prohibits use of ballast tank, ballast bags or fins to cause boat to operate in bow-high manner, no person may operate a boat in an artificially bow-high manner, excludes water skiing, tubing, wake boarding with a tow rope, and/or brief transition operation to empty a boat of bilge water or accelerate into a planning position. Motion made by Moderow and second by Berndt to accept the enact ordinance restricting certain artificial wake enhancement on Little Green Lake. Motion carried.

2025 Roads – Chris was there to report for Lukasz. Lukasz just received access to the WISLAR program. Kartechner plans to fix the road this coming week. In the next week or so the shoulder work should be completed as well.

White Circle Road Easements – Chairman Moderow read the emailed he received from Sondalle about the process. After discussion, the board agreed that this would not be very cost effective. The board did not take any action on this.
