

Town of Green Lake
Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, March 9, 2026

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present. There was 1 citizen in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Strelow, seconded by Berndt to approve the minutes of the regular monthly meeting on February 9, 2026. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – the board members reviewed January report. There were \$3,711.13 in credits and \$4,437,910.72 debits. There will be a correction to the Phelps Account for \$27,2710.25 credit. Reported balances on Money Market, CD and Phelps Savings Account. Motion to approve Treasurer's report and the transfer needed as presented by Berndt, seconded by Strelow. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – Dan reported dead tree at Phelps Cemetery was removed and stump will be ground this summer. The tree at Kearley's that was damaged last summer has been taken down also. The small brush across from W2925 and W2931 was cleaned up as it was getting into the roadway on Kahl Road. Fiegel Road has been brushed but still needs to have the limbs trimmed with the bucket truck. We replaced the chipper blades and bolts as we hit some metal that was in the tree limb at Phelps Cemetery. The pick up was taken to Homen Ford to replace the heat door in the dash. The 99 truck is working well. The passenger rear spring was replaced as well as the hinge for the box that was twisted. The box rails were cut out and reinforced as they were rusted out. The toilets in the town hall have been replaced as there was an issue when the hall was last rented. On Wednesday, March 4th we installed the weight limit signs as the county did that day as well. We used approximately 120 tons of salt this winter. Mid-March the 2026-2027 salt contracts come out. Also, this month that salt shed inspections will take place. The county will be spraying the ditches for noxious weeds; they will not be doing roads around the lakes.

Fire Dept Billing – At the last fire dept meeting they talked about fire call billing. This will be discussed at the next fire meeting again.

2026 Roads – Road Project for 2026, paving Prairie Road, Crack filling Prairie Road south of Miller Road, North Kearly Road and McAfee Road. Then chip sealing Utlely Road to Tichora to County Road A, Fiegel Road, and Boelter Road.

Open Book and Board of Review dates and Training – Clerk Mehn received an email from Ryan at Municipal Group that we will have Open Book on Thursday, April 30th from 8:00 AM until 10:00 AM at the town hall. Board of Review is scheduled for Monday, May 11th at 4:30 until 6:30 PM. Supervisor Strelow and Clerk Mehn plan to take the Board of Review training in March with the Wisconsin Town Association.

Annual meeting date – will be held on the third Tuesday of April. Our annual meeting will be on Tuesday, April 21st @ 6:00 PM. Motion made by Berndt/Strelow. Motion carried.
