## Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, September 8, 2025

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Supervisor Berndt was absent. There were 5 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Strelow/Moderow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Strelow/Moderow to approve the minutes from the regular monthly meeting on Monday, August 11, 2025. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Moderow/Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

**Treasurer Report** – Machkovich reported the August credits are \$234,257.37 and the debits are \$266,864.74. \$278,587.00 is the remaining balance on the loan. No transfer requested by Machkovich. Motion was made by Moderow/Strelow to approve the treasurer's report.

Maintenance Report – The stop-sign and stop-ahead-sign and post have been installed on Tuleta Hills Road at Oakwood. The concrete has been removed from Grand Prairie Cemetery. Consider a new fence around and we can remove brush this fall and winter. We've continued patching potholes and broken edges on the roads. Replaced the plow blades on the larger (99 and 18) trucks as the carbide was worn through and leaving an inch of snow on the road. The fire department came and did a walk through. The exit signs in the stop weren't lighting up. Took them apart and cleaned them.

Everything else was good. The county will be willing to spray the ditches at a cost of \$300 per mile. The mile wage will be 35.6 – 40 miles. I can get the town on the list now as others are interested. The last of the storm damaged tress will be cleaned up this week. Scotts is planning by the end of September to have the roads swept. I swept intersections on the outlying roads that were done. The dirt has been placed and seeded on Menominee.

**Marquette Volunteer Fire Department** – Chairman Moderow read the letter from the Marquette Volunteer Fire Department asking for donation for the fireworks. The board discussed and a motion was made to deny their request by Moderow, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Strelow to the donation. Motion carried.

**Ditch spraying** – The total roads are 52, they would be spraying about 35.6-40 miles. It would help with the noxious weeds. A motion was made by Moderow/Strelow to get on the county's list for road spraying.

## Audience Participation -

Wally Szkwarko – talked with the new assessor and was very pleased with him. Also, let the board know he talked with Adam about the construction sites on Spring Grove Road and cleaning up the road.

Rick Potter – talked about his concerns when the road was resurfaced on Oakwood Beach Road that it would be nice to know when they are coming and his concerns about the loose gravel.
